## **MENA Regional Meeting of the 2024 Global Research Council**

**3-4 December 2024**

**Nouakchott - Mauritania**



## Introduction

**Mauritania participated for the first time in the High-Level Meeting of the Heads of Regional Research Councils in the Middle East and North Africa (MENA) region, which was held in Doha, Qatar 2023. During this meeting, the National Agency for Scientific Research and Innovation of Mauritania expressed its willingness to host The 2024 Regional Meeting in the MENA region in Nouakchott., with the National Center for Scientific and Technical Research (CNRST) in Morocco designated as a co-host for the event.**

**The Meeting brought together a distinguished Heads and senior officials from regional research councils across the MENA region, along with observers from research councils outside the region.**

**The Meeting's discussions centered on key scientific research priorities, including artificial intelligence, co-creation, regional collaboration, and shared challenges facing countries in the region.**

## Meeting Objectives

**The Meeting was part of the ongoing efforts of the Global Research Council and the MENA Secretariat to strengthen scientific collaboration among countries in the region. The event focused on:**

- **Enhancing regional and international research cooperation.**
- **Discussing recent advancements in research management.**
- **Reviewing member states' experiences and sharing best practices.**
- **Addressing common research challenges.**
- **Developing action plans to tackle the region's challenges through joint research initiatives.**
- **Formulating recommendations to be presented at the upcoming Global Research Council meeting in Riyadh.**

- Established in 2012 as a virtual, informal organization bringing together heads of science and engineering funding agencies worldwide.
- Focuses on sharing data, promoting collaboration, and fostering diversity and inclusion in global research.

→ **Organizational Goals:**

- Enhance research quality and funding.
- Address global challenges collectively and efficiently.
- Support member organizations in capacity building and adopting shared principles.

→ **Structure of the GRC:**

- Governed by a board with representatives from five global regions (Americas, Asia-Pacific, Europe, MENA, and Sub-Saharan Africa).
- Supported by the Executive Support Group (ESG) for continuity and operational transparency.

→ **Key Initiatives:**

- Equality, Diversity, and Inclusion (EDI): Promoting inclusive research environments.
- Responsible Research Assessment (RRA): Advocating for responsible and transparent research evaluation practices.
- Multilateral Engagement (MLE): Developing funding mechanisms for global collaboration.



→ **Yearly Activities:**

- Annual meetings to discuss global topics such as AI in research and co-creation for global challenges.
- Regional meetings to align efforts and exchange good practices.

→ **Future Plans:**

- 2025 Annual Meeting in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia, focusing on AI and global collaboration.
- Calls for hosting side events and future meetings.

## Recommendations

- Call for continuing to prepare and implement the three agreed upon programmes approved at the Interlaken meeting
- Strengthen the region's role within the council and activate the necessary measures to achieve this goal.
- Implement the accession plan for joining the Global Research Council.
- Prepare detailed program reports to assess progress and outcomes.
- Enhance research and human capacity building to support the dissemination and shared utilization of existing research infrastructure, with recommendations presented to universities.
- Produce a quarterly report to track developments and progress.
- Establish partnerships and agreements among the research councils of member states to foster regional collaboration.
- Engage with non-member countries during high-level meetings to encourage their participation and promote cooperation among member states.
- Approve and adopt the high-level program after finalizing and endorsing the executive plan.
- Provide opportunities for participating entities to host council activities, ensuring the selected hosts have prior experience and expertise.
- Encourage the utilization of the local initiatives to strengthen the local efforts.
- Agreement to adopt a rotational cycle of hosting the future MENA Regional meetings based on the previous rounds of hosting the regional meetings. The initial agreements of the MENA Regional Meeting main host are as follows:
  - 2025 Egypt
  - 2026 Saudi Arabia
  - 2027 Lebanon
  - 2028 Kuwait
  - 2029 Oman
  - 2030 Qatar
  - 2031 Morocco
- The initial hosting countries of the MENA Regional Meeting are flexible and could be amended if the meeting cannot be hosted in the recommended host country, provided advance notice and coordination with the regional secretariat and the regional representative of the region at the GRC ESG.

## Conclusion

Mauritania's hosting of this conference presented a successful model of regional and international collaboration in the field of scientific research. The outcomes of this meeting will potentially be posted on the GRC website aiming to communicate and inform the regional outcomes with the other regional HORCS, further solidifying the position of the Middle East and North Africa region on the global research agenda.
